PAJAMA PARTY Program Overview

Making Pajamas is an excellent project for a beginner and a fun project for a skilled sewer. If you enrolled in a beginning sewing class and made a pair of pajamas, it would take approximately nine hours of classroom time. So, go slowly, work through the project in steps or better yet, sew with a friend! You'll find some great files to download that detail laying out, cutting and marking your pattern and fabric. We have broken the program down into scenes to allow you to stop and come back at another time to continue on.

You can view the program from start to finish by selecting at the Main Menu "Play All". You can view individual steps in the pajama bottoms construction by selecting at the Main Menu "Pajama Bottoms Scene Select". There are 7 scenes to choose from:

1. Basic Overview
2. Tools and Taking Measurements

You'll need a pattern, we use Butterick 6837 available at your local fabric store or online at www.butterick.com. Refer to your pattern to determine the amount of fabric and any special notions such as buttons and elastic. You will also need a sewing machine, new needle, thread, tape measure, cutting tools, point turner; marking tools, pins, iron and ironing board.

3. Preparing the Fabric

We recommend that you pre-wash and dry your fabric. When dry, iron if necessary.

4. Adjusting the Pattern and Cutting Out
5. Sewing the Bottoms
6. Fitting the Bottoms
7. Finishing the Bottoms

You can view individual steps in the pajama top construction by selecting at the Main Menu "Pajama Top Scene Select". There are 7 scenes to choose from:

1. Understanding the Pattern Pieces
2. The Pocket
3. Preparing the Collar
4. Sewing the Collar On
5. Sewing the Sleeves On
6. Fitting the Top
7. Buttonholes and Buttons

There are several "Special Features" on the DVD located at the Main Menu. You will find overviews and information pertaining to sewing machines, notions, and information about your hosts.
